- Prior permission must be taken before bringing hazardous Cargo inside the ICD –Sanand.
- GST or Taxes will be levied as applicable.

22) Left Out Packing Material Of Import / Export Cargo Consignment Should Be Taken Away Within 3 Days By Cha / Consignee / Shipper / Transporter. After 3 Days , Left Out Packing Material Will Be Disposed Off Without Any Intimation.

23) Admin Charges And Infra Charges Will Be Applicable At Rs1500/20 Ft And Rs3000/40 Ft For All Export And Import Laden Boxes.

24) If containers are moved out of ICD on non-returnable basis by Road on Pvt. Vehicles Double Additional Charges (Documentation & Surveyor charges, Data charges, Infrastructure &

Development charges) will be levied. (once for Inward Empty & other for exit by road on non-returnable basis).

- 25) If Any Leftout Packing Material Is Required To Be Store, It Has To Be Informed Well In Advance To Make An Arrangement For Storage In Icd. Storage Charges Will Be Applicable As Per Sqft/
- 26) All Booking Will Be Accepted By Thar On "Paid" Basis
- 27) All Exporters/Chas Are Requested to Fill In And Present One Forwarding Note Of Each Shipment Along With One Copy Of Shipping Bill Duly Endorsed By Customs For Iw Bill.
- 28) Import Loaded Containers Shall Be Moved For Examination Only After All Customs And Other Formalities Have Been Completed And Custom Examination Arranged by Shipper/Agent.
- 29) Thar Would Reserve The Right To Decide Which Import Container And What Kind Of Import Commodities Are To Be Destuffed In The Icd Warehouse Or In The Nominated Open Space. For Rest, The Cargo Will Be Left In The Container Itself Till Final Delivery Is Taken By The Shipper Or Custom/Thar Disposes Off The Goods Following Procedures Laid Down By Custom And As Specified In Indian Customs Act.
- 30) All Exporters / Importers /Cha / Shipping Lines /Forwarders / Consolidators Bringing In Their Cargo Or Containers In Icd Sanand Are Advised To Take Suitable Insurance Cover For Them.
- 31) The Arrival , Placement And Examination Of Trains Are Unscheduled And Subject To Various Conditions Controlled By External Forces. The Ideal Transit Times Are Estimates And Thar Does Not Guarantee On Transit Time Either For Rail Or Road Transportation.
- 32) If dues remain unpaid, Thar will D-stuff the cargo subject to the feasibility of operations as assessed by Thar. In such cases, all applicable tariff of Export and Import of either handling, TSC, Wharfage or any charges etc. will have to be borne by the Customer and they will also arrange for NOC from Customs. If it is not feasible to destuff the cargo or Customs permission is not available, then the customer will bear any detention charges payable to the shipping line. Alternatively, Thar may recover the dues from the PDA of the Customer.
- 33) If any special equipment is required for loading / unloading, then charges will be extra on case to case basis.
